- 4.2 A copy of bachelor's degree transcript must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00 and no grade F in core subjects**
- 4.3 A copy of Master's degree transcript must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25**
- 4.4 A copy of Doctor's degree transcript
- 4.5 A copy of passport
- 4.6 General Medical examination certificate

- 4.7 Psychological examinations (fees for the test 500 baht absorbed by applicants)
- 4.8 One official photo, one or two inch square
- 4.9 Three letters of recommendation
- 4.10 Certificate of work experience


